WORSHIP

Worship services are held each Sunday at 11:00 a.m. During Lent evening services are at 7:00 p.m. Wednesday. Special services are also held during Christmas, Holy Week and Easter. Holy Communion takes place on the second and fourth Sundays of each month. Greeters are at the door each Sunday. They are there to make you feel more welcome.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Our congregation offers Christian Education each Sunday morning. Sunday School classes for pre-school children to pre-teens are held in the basement of the church beginning at 9:45 a.m. The Sunday School year begins in September and gets off to a great start with Rally Day. The Sunday School children sing in worship services on a regular basis. They also present a Christmas program and take part in Palm Sunday celebrations.

An adult Bible Study led by the Pastor or a Layman is held at 9:30 a.m. on Sunday mornings. Other Bible Studies are held periodically throughout the year. Occasional gym night and other fellowship nights are also held during the year.

Vacation Bible School is held for a week in July or August for children ages 3 - 12.

LITTLE LEARNERS CHRISTIAN NURSERY SCHOOL

Little Learners Christian Nursery School meets Mondays and Thursdays from September to the end of May in the church basement. The 3 year old class is taught by Mrs. Wendy Kuenzel (B.A. in Child Studies, B. Ed.) and 4 year old classes are taught by Mrs. Carol Haberstock (certified teacher). The preschool provides opportunity for social interaction and a variety of learning activities and is centered around Bible Stories and Christian teachings. Because of the Nursery School families with no church affiliation have been invited and taken part in worship and other church activities.

ST. PETER'S WOMEN'S MISSION CIRCLE

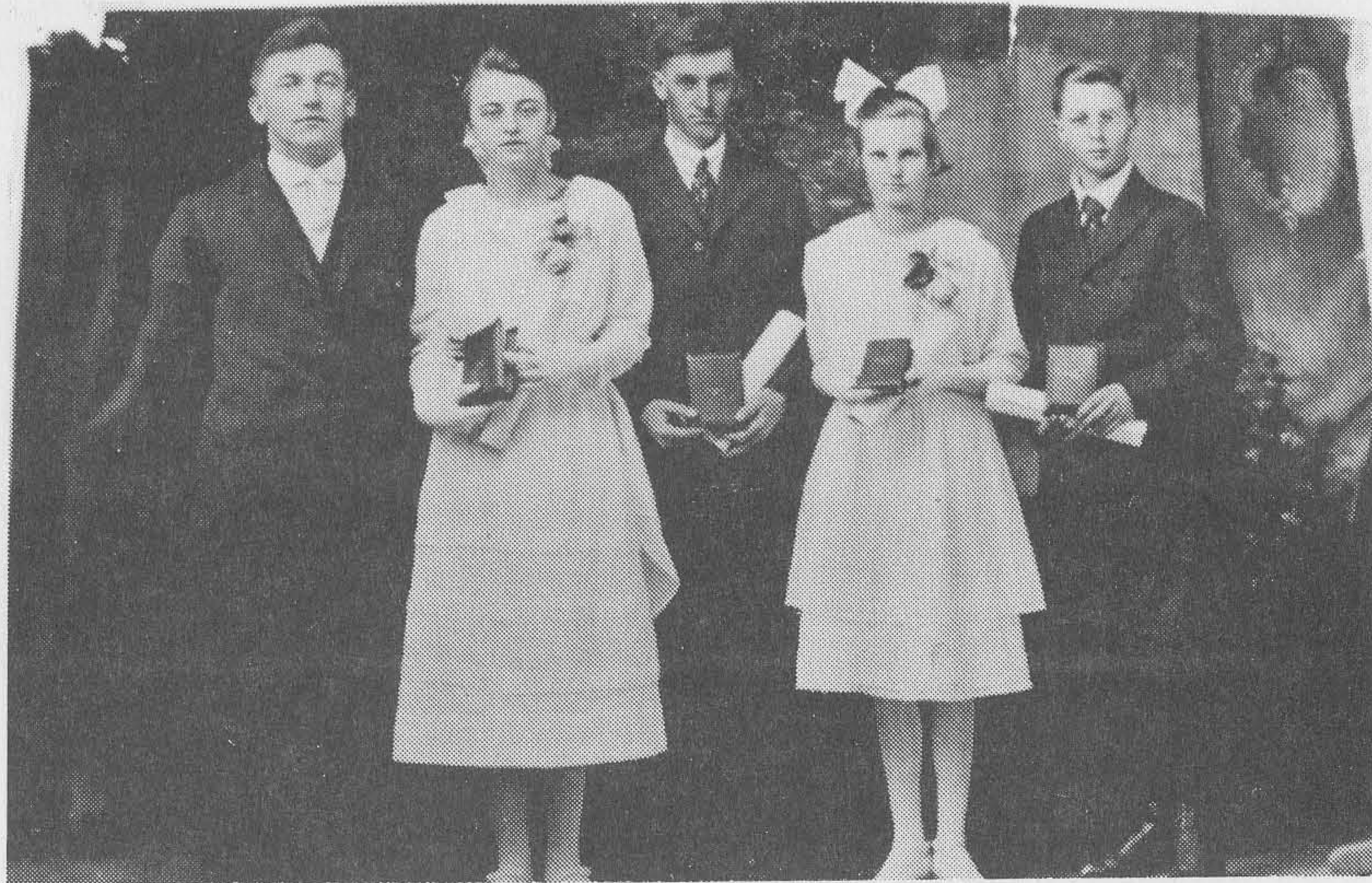
The Mission Circle was organized by Pastor Ludwig in 1932. There were many projects which the Mission Circle took on—purchasing organ, putting in water and sewer system in the church on 3rd Street. In the 60's and 70's the ladies continued the Lord's work, such as donating to many organizations. Pastor Holm joined us in 1960 and the new church was dedicated on November 22, 1964. The ladies helped serve the meal at the dedication. In the fall of 1982 the Mission Circle celebrated their 50th Anniversary. In the past 5 years more dishes were bought, large coffee urns, serving carts, coffee servers, dish washer, tea towels, and many other items. We now have 19 members, and 9 honorary members over 70 years. The work still gets done with the help of the women in the Congregation which we really appreciate. With God's help we will serve and support the church and serve for funerals without charge, only a free will offering. God has been good to us and we will continue to do the work that was started in 1932.
